CONSENT FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE AND RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK WAIVER, and CONDUCT
 As a parent/legal guardian of the listed player, I hereby give consent for emergency medical care or action deemed necessary by anyone present in order to ensure that the most immediate treatment can be obtained. This treatment may be given under whatever conditions are necessary in order to preserve the life or well being of this player. I hereby release and discharge, indemnify and hold harmless FCBC and its, members, officers, agents, employees and any other persons or entities acting on their behalf against all claims, demands and causes of action relating to injury, disability, death or other harm, to person property or both, arising from participation in the FCBC program. I have been informed of and am aware of and assume all risks and dangers incidental to and inherent in the game of baseball including specifically, but not exclusively, the danger of being injured by baseball bats and hit or thrown balls and waive all claims against FCBC and the aforementioned entities and individuals.

- I understand that I am solely responsible for any cost arising out of any bodily injury, property damage, and medical evacuation expense or rescue expenses sustained through my child's participation in the FCBC Program.
- I understand and agree that FCBC may require proof of age or grade from any player.
- I agree to provide such proof, and, if such proof is insufficient, that FCBC may obtain such information through the Office of Vital Statistics. Anyone found knowingly giving false information to FCBC is subject to disciplinary action, which could include immediate dismissal and revocation of "member in good standing" status. All parties to the registration process agree to abide by and uphold the rules and regulations of FCBC.
- Objectionable conduct or behavior, including profane and/or abusive language by players or parents will not be tolerated, and may preclude players' or parents' participation in FCBC sanctioned events.

The Mission of Fort Collins Baseball Club's (FCBC) Recreational Program is to promote an educational and instructional program for individuals in the Fort Collins area. The FCBC recreational program promotes full player participation which includes the development of a healthy attitude toward sportsmanship and respect for authority, together with instruction in baseball rules, skills, and the element of healthy and positive play.

As a **Parent** of an official registered player in the FCBC Recreational or Intermediate Program, I understand that I have a responsibility as a role model and that my actions are visible to players, parents, umpires and league officials.

Therefore, I agree to uphold the following standards:

- I will treat each individual (player, opposing coach, official, parent, or administrator) with respect and dignity and exhibit exemplary conduct at games and practices.
- I will not engage in any negative emotional, psychological, or physical contact toward anyone involved with FCBC.
- I will respect the judgment, strategy, and decision-making processes of the coaches, and will not publicly criticize coaches or players.
- I will not confront a coach regarding a disagreement before 24 hours following a game, nor will I confront the coach before or during the game.
- I will temper my reactions and investigate situations before taking action.
- I will attempt to understand the National Federation of State High School Association baseball rules, including the FCBC Recreational Rule Modifications established for my team's age group.
- I will show respect and support the authority of officials who are assigned to the game and will not hold them or unforeseen weather accountable for game results.
- I will show compassion for any injured player and will applaud good play by either team.
- I will not heckle, jeer, or distract players of any team and will avoid the use of profanity or other inappropriate language or behavior.
- I will not give false or misleading information of any kind to FCBC.

In order for FCBC to register a player, this FCBC Parental Standards of Conduct Form must accompany the Player Registration Form.

Failure to adhere to the Parental Standards of Conduct can result in disciplinary actions including, but not limited to, suspension or removal from the program. Any disciplinary action may be **appealed in writing to FCBC within two weeks. A hearing will be convened within two weeks of a written appeal.**
